What is Local Green Space designation?

Local Green Space designation is a way to provide special protection against development for green areas of particular importance to local communities.

In our Neighbourhood plan we are able to designate areas of Local Green Space for special protection. While this designation will not be appropriate for most green areas or open space, it can be used:

- where the green space is in reasonably close proximity to the community it serves;
- where the green area is special to a local community and holds a particular local significance, for example because of its recreational value, beauty, tranquillity or richness of its wildlife; and
- where the green area concerned is not an extensive tract of land.

We are looking for help from you to suggest land that is special to our community and which deserves protection. Local examples might include the open areas between Brandon Road and Jessett Drive or at the Western end of Silvester Way on Zebon Copse as well as “The Crescent” in Crookham Village.
